Doctoral Program in Architecture "Architecture, representation and image"

The Doctoral Programme in Architecture promotes a training methodology and learning environment appropriate to update and improve the acquisition of new skills in the different expertise areas, essential to the construction of a research autonomous pathway by the students.

The 2017/2018 edition of the Doctoral Program in Architecture, in the area of Architectural Culture, will be open under the theme: Architecture, representation and image. This theme intends to reflect on the means of representation that accompany the thinking and doing of architecture in its different phases. At the centre is the image as a vehicle but also a privileged place for comprehensive communication. From a circular structure, it is proposed to develop a reflection on memory and knowledge; analysis; concept; project; technique; construction; communication; mediation; filing (and consequent production of new memory and knowledge). Under the thematic of representation, image can be understood in-between the image reminiscent and evocative of a past, and the prescient and evocative image of a future, meaning, between its analytical nature and its projectual nature. In summary, we can ask, provocatively, could there be architecture without representation?

1. Access

Vacancies for the academic year 2017/2018: 25

Minimum number of registrations: 7

2. Formal Requirements

May apply to the Doctoral Program in Architecture:

- a) The holder of a Master's degree or legal equivalent;
- b) Holders of a degree, with at least 300 credits, holders of an academic and scientific especially relevant that is recognized as attesting the capacity to carry out the PhD by the Scientific Council of "Architecture School," after consulting the Steering Committee;
- c) Holders of a school curriculum, scientific or professional recognized as attesting the capacity to carry out the PhD by the Scientific Council, after consulting with the Steering Committee.

The recognition referred to in subparagraphs b) and c) above has the effect only access to the course of study leading to the PhD degree and does not confer on its holder, the equivalence of the degree of bachelor or master, or recognition.

3. Application deadlines

1st Phase: From October 16 to November 15, 2017

2nd Phase: From December 01 to December 15, 2017

4. Application

To apply, the following documents must be submitted to the email 3ciclo@arquitectura.uminho.pt, within the given deadlines:

- a) Application form;
- b) Certificate of education degrees (Degree, Master or others);
- c) Curriculum Vitae (consisting of general information, academic and/or professional background, scientific production and other production, according to the model of the application form);
- d) Letter of motivation (limited to 1,500 words), which is an important element of selection and ranking of candidates. The letter should include the area of specialization you are applying for and the reasons for submitting the application. Focus on objective scientific and professional issues (not personal), showing the congruence between objectives and future personal projects and objectives of the Doctoral Programme in Architecture. Avoid listing curricular data and describing the activities already mentioned in the CV;
- e) Bead proof of payment of the application fee (30€).
- f) Photocopy of ID card and VAT number card;
- g) Other information considered relevant (ex: recommendation letters)
